第一條 宗旨

國立陽明交通大學文化研究國際中心暨台灣聯合大學系統文化研究國際中心(以下簡稱本中心)為推動中心執行之整合型研究計畫,培養及拓展中心研究群及合作單位研究生之研究能力,促進亞際文化研究領域之合作與交流,特設立此辦法,鼓勵學生共同執行小型研究團隊,進行多元形態的知識生產。

第二條 申請資格及注意事項

- 1. 參與本中心整合型研究計畫之研究員所指導或推薦之研究生。
- 2. 研究生需為在台就讀中之碩、博士學生。
- 3. 研究小組成員至少三人,上限十人。
- 4. 研究生小組必須負責研究計畫的發想與執行,定期進行交流,並與指導老師討論。
- 5. 指導老師負責評估研究計畫之可行性,並給予最終研究成果的評估意見。

第三條 檢附資料

- 1. 文化研究國際中心學生研究小組計畫申請書及經費預算表。
 - A. 計畫申請書(2000字以內,並包含以下內容)
 - i. 研究計畫:a)問題意識;b)研究背景;c)研究目標;d)執行方式;e)預期成果:研究目標及成果展現之形式概述·例如:學術研究論文、系列短文、小誌、刊物、影片/紀錄片、策展、網站等;f)與中心整合型研究計畫之關聯性。

- iv. 研究成果報告·最晚需於研究小組計畫結執行期間結束後三個月內繳交。若無法如期繳交·學生研究小組將無法支領剩餘補助經費·並應將全數補助金額歸還。

International Center for Cultural Studies, National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University International Institute for Cultural Studies, University System of Taiwan Operation Guidelines for the ICCS Students Group Research Grant

1. **Objective**

In regard to facilitate Integrated Research Project, the International Center for Cultural Studies(Hereinafter as the ICCS), National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University and the International Institute for Cultural Studies, University System of Taiwan, has now launched a Group Research Grant for the ICCS Students. We encourage graduate students to get together to formulate small research groups and to produce diverse knowledge. By this grant scheme, we aim to cultivate and expand the research capabilities of our center as well as our fellow students in cooperation units. And as a result, we look forward to promote cooperation and exchanges in the field of Inter-Asian Cultural Studies.

2. **[Eligibility Requirements and Further Information]**

- i. Graduate students instructed or recommended by the ICCS researchers involved in the IRP.
- ii. Graduate students who are either master or doctoral students in Taiwan.
- iii. The research group can involve a minimum of 3 and up to 10 members.
- iv. The research group is responsible for the development and execution of the research project. Regular meetings, and discussions with the instructor are required.
- v. The instructor has no role in assessing the feasibility of the group research project as well as commenting on the final research outcomes.

3. **[Required Documents]**

**Research Plan and Budget Plan must be included in your application

A. Research Plan (no more than 2000 words, required information as follows:

- Research Proposal: a) Problematics; b) Background; c) Objectives; d) Methodology; e)
 Expected Outcomes(presentation of research objectives and outcomes, such as academic
 research papers, series of essays, blogs, publications, films/documentaries, exhibitions,
 websites)
- List of Members: Name, Institute, Descriptions, and Job Duties of each members
- Work Schedule: work schedule of the research project includes meeting, preparations, event planning, outcomes delivery and any related activities in the estimated timetables.
 You are welcome to present it in a Gantt chart. (Please refer to the outcome delivery section in Rule 4)
- Other Supplementary Documents: previous related research works

B. Budget Plan(maximum \$100,000 allowable expenses in principal)

Please explain the reasons for the use of funds in 500 words and list them in a budget table. The Budget Plan should cover every expenses related to the group research and they should be listed properly. The grant items are the expenses for the research group members to implement the

project, such as research expenses, printing fees, editing fees, design fees, postage, lecture fee, and speaker transportation expenses.

4. [Outcome Delivery]

- i. After review by the instructor, the Research Outcomes Report must be submitted either to the ICCS's CJD platform. (https://cjdproject.web.nycu.edu.tw/)
- ii. The research group is required to provide a Summary of the Research Outcomes(800-1000 words, with photos attached), which will be published on the center's website and annual report.
- iii. An acknowledgement of "This work was supported by the International Center for Cultural Studies, ICCS_NYCU (Awardee of Research Center for the Special Fields Program, Higher Education SPROUT Project)" should be included in any relevant publications of the research project.
- iv. The Research Outcomes Report must be submitted within 3 months after the end of the research project's work duration. Research groups who fail to do will not be received the rest of the grant and the entire grant amount must be returned.

Remarks:

Application Period:

- From now until Oct 15th,2023, Funding decisions will be announced by the End of October
- Research group project execution period: From November 1, 2023, to April 1, 2024.

- You will be contacted if we require additional information to process your application.
 Please resubmit all the required documentation at one time to assist in streamlining the assessment of applications.

Funding Disbursement Explanation

Subsidy funds will be disbursed in two stages. After the announcement of the review results, 50% of the subsidy funds will be disbursed. The remaining funds will be disbursed after the research group submits a summary of the research results.

***"If the research group is unable to submit the results report within three months after the execution period, then the entire grant amount must be refunded.

Announcement of Application Results:

The application will be reviewed by the Student Affairs Committee of the ICCS. Funding decisions will be announced on the center's website and the granted research group will be notified.
